

**2** ot Sharpe's career with the US Postal Service began in 1964, and what a stellar career it turned out to be! Beginning as secretary, she served in five (5) functional areas in the Memphis Regional Office. She was promoted to EEO Investigator in 1978, and from there advanced to Southern Region Women's Program Manager, National Women's Program Manager, then, General Manager of the Affirmative Action Division, at US Postal Service Headquarters, Washington, DC.

In 1987, Dorothy D. Sharpe was the General Manager, Affirmative Action Division, Headquarters. She was previously a Diversity Development Specialist and Civil & Equal Rights Activist. She started the famous Career Awareness Conferences to assist those who wanted to move up.

She was well known throughout the agency and without her efforts in promoting the principles of equal employment opportunity and affirmative action. During her career, she successfully

implemented, administered, and monitored nationwide Postal Policies and actions to ensure compliance with EEO, Affirmative Action, and Diversity Development. In 1995, she assisted in developing the Postal Service's presentation material for the United Nations Forum on Women in Beijing China. For her outstanding efforts she received numerous Honors and Awards, including the prestigious Postmaster General Award for Executive Achievement. She was a founding member of A-PLUS (African American Postal League United for Success), a lifetime member of Federally Employed Women, and founding member of NETWORK, a mentoring organization for those seeking upward mobility.

What is known is the outpouring of appreciation attributed to her love, dedication, and commitment to assist others whenever or wherever needed. Dot was not contained by pay levels. She worked with all regardless of your pay level.

- Must provide an official grade transcript.
- Must compose an original two (2) page type written (1000 word maximum) essay identifying their career goals & objectives.
- Include in written essay examples of community involvement.
- Provide two letters of reference, one from a current professor and/or teacher and one from a non-relative.
- Include a professional business photograph or school ID photograph (passport or wallet size) with application.
- Must use the official application form provided by A-PLUS for 2024.
- Must be sponsored by an A-PLUS paid member in good standing for 2024.
- Applicant must be a family member of an A-PLUS member in good standing.
- All requested information must be provided to the A-PLUS sponsor who will verify applicant is an A-PLUS family member.
- The A-PLUS sponsor will submit all required documents to the address listed for the scholarship.
- All information must be provided to qualify for scholarship consideration.
